



POOL RULES, REGULATIONS & ETIQUETTE

*The pool is for the benefit and enjoyment of members and their guests.
Please be considerate of others when using the facility. Thank you.*

Pool Attendant

- The pool attendant is in complete charge of the pool area and has the authority to ask anyone to leave the pool if that person disobeys the safety rules, or if his/her conduct is detrimental to the common pleasure of the other members at the pool. The pool attendant has the right to deny the use of the pool to anyone who repeatedly violates the rules.
- The following are not allowed in the pool, on the pool deck or in pavilion area:
 - Running
 - Yelling/screaming
 - Rough play
 - Hanging on lane lines/rope
 - Hard balls
 - Opening skimmers
 - Glass containers of any kind
- Families are permitted to have one sitter bring dependent children to the pool. The sitter must be at least 16 years of age. Guests are not allowed with the sitter.
- All persons using the pool, including guests, must check in before entering the pool area.

Guests Fees

- Monday – Thursday \$5 per person.
- Friday – Sunday \$8 per person.
- Fees can be paid at the window using cash or credit card on file.
- Pool parties (10 or more guests) must be scheduled at least 1 week in advance and are based on availability. A Pool Party Agreement must be in signed ahead of the event.
- Food and beverages cannot be consumed while in the pool and must be kept a safe distance from the pool at all times.
- Children are to be monitored by parents or guardians at all times. No child will be allowed to leave the pool area unless accompanied by parent or guardian.



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Safety

- Persons with skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections may not enter the pool.
- Persons with open lesions or wounds may not enter the pool.
- Use of pool shall be prohibited during severe weather conditions. All guests must leave the pool at the sound of thunder and remain out of the water for 15 minutes. If another clap of thunder sounds, the clock will restart. At no time will anyone be allowed in the water when it is lightning. On rainy days, it's best to call the office at 843-225-2675 to check if the pool will be open.
- **DIAL 911 FOR ANY EMERGENCY SITUATION.** Pool attendant should be notified immediately.

Food/Drink Orders

- All food and drink orders will be charged to the members' card on file unless cash payment is preferred.

Lost and Found

Any items found at the pool will be put in the black container along the fence inside the gate entrance.

Hours / Events

- April 30 – September 6th:
 - Sunday – Thursday 10 a.m. – 8 p.m.
 - Friday & Saturday 10 a.m. – 9 p.m.
 - Adult lap swim 9 a.m. – 10 a.m. daily
- September 6th – October 30th:
 - Mondays and Tuesdays - Closed
 - Wednesday – Sunday 11 a.m. – 7 p.m.
 - Saturday 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.
 - Adult lap swim 9 a.m. – 10 a.m. daily

There will be swim meets scheduled throughout the year and the Shadowmoss Sharks Swim Team will commence practices April 25th. They will use 4 lanes Monday - Friday from 4 – 7:30 p.m. We will send out communication to all pool members when other events are taking place, i.e. swim meets and/or special events which may affect pool availability.
