



# POOL RULES, REGULATIONS & ETIQUETTE 2023

*The pool is for the benefit and enjoyment of members and their guests.*

## General

- The pool attendant is in complete charge of the pool area and has the authority to ask anyone to leave the pool if that person disobeys the safety rules, or if his/her conduct is detrimental to the common pleasure of the other members at the pool. The pool attendant has the right to deny the use of the pool to anyone who repeatedly violates the rules.
- The following are not allowed in the pool, on the pool deck or in pavilion area:
  - Running
  - Yelling/screaming
  - Rough play
  - Hanging on lane lines/rope
  - Footballs
  - Hard balls
  - Opening skimmers
  - Glass containers of any kind
  - Some floats are restricted  
Please see pool float policy
- Food and beverages cannot be consumed while in the pool and must be kept a safe distance from the pool at all times.
- Children are to be monitored by parents or guardians at all times. No child will be allowed to leave the pool area unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- All persons using the pool, including guests, must check in before entering the pool area.

## Guests & Parties

- Monday – Thursday \$5 per person.
- Friday – Sunday & Holidays \$8 per person.
- Fees can be paid at the window using cash or credit card on file.
- Families are permitted to have one sitter bring dependent children to the pool. The sitter must be at least 16 years of age. Guests are not allowed with the sitter.
- Pool parties (10 or more guests) must be scheduled at least 1 week in advance and are based on availability. A Pool Party Agreement must be signed ahead of the event.

## Safety

- Persons with skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections may not enter the pool.
- Persons with open lesions or wounds may not enter the pool.
- Use of the pool shall be prohibited during severe weather conditions. All guests must leave the pool at the sound of thunder and remain out of the water for 30 minutes. If another clap of thunder sounds, the clock will restart. At no time will anyone be allowed in the water when it is lightning. On rainy days, it's best to call the office at 843-225-2675 to check if the pool will be open.
- **DIAL 911 FOR ANY EMERGENCY SITUATION.** Pool attendant should be notified immediately.

## Food/Drink Orders

All food and drink orders will be charged to the members' card on file unless cash payment is preferred.

## Lost and Found

Any items found at the pool will be put in the black container along the fence inside the gate entrance.

## Hours of Operation

May 1st – September 4th:

- Daily: 9 a.m. – 10 a.m. Lap Swim\*
- Daily: 10 a.m. – 8 p.m. Open Swim

September 5th – October 1st:

- Mondays & Tuesdays - Closed
- Wednesday – Sunday: 9 a.m. – 10 a.m. Lap Swim\*
- Wednesday – Sunday: 10 a.m. – 7 p.m. Open Swim

\*Lap swim will be open to all ages. The deep end will be open to non lap swimmers during this time along with the baby pool.
