## Cart Paths

We are excited to announce that we will likely begin cart path repaving in November. We have signed the contract and are just awaiting the confirmation on scheduling. The work will consist of grinding down all of the rough areas and then applying 1 1/2 inches of new asphalt to the entire course. We will also be adding the parking areas in front of both of the course restrooms. We will be working with the contractor to try to isolate work to a couple holes at a time to minimize the disturbance to our members and guests. We are expecting the work to take 3-5 weeks to complete but it will be very weather dependent.

## Middleborough Condos

The developers of the Middleborough Condos along hole #14 are getting close to being able to resume work. Much of the area that was originally scheduled to be developed was rezoned as wetlands and the entire project had to be adjusted. In order to proceed the developers had to have more water retention. The new design includes the developer extending the pond down the remainder of hole #13 and ending behind #12 green. The contractor will also be digging out the pond behind #11 green in order to increase retention and decrease the amount of vegetative growth. They are hoping to begin work this fall. We will keep you informed of the timeline as we are made aware.
