## Fitness Center

This will give us additional teeing space that will help us to maintain a better playing surface. We are also having them enlarge the forward tee on the new #1. This tee will be much larger than the existing and will be home to the black and green tee markers.

## Flipping of the Nines

The nines have now officially been reversed. We have made this change for the following reasons:

- The tees on the former back nine are larger and about 25% of our play is only 9 holes.
- Some golfers do not like finishing an 18 hole round on a par 3
- Our new finishing holes are 2 of the most difficult holes on the course.

## Bunker Renovations

We have completed renovations of the greenside bunkers for holes 8 and 16. The renovation process included:

- Removal of all the old sand and silt
- Reshaping as needed
- Installation of drainage
- Application of 2 inches of capillary concrete
- Filling of the bunker with 4 inches of sand

Three bunkers were renovated and two were removed. Of the three that were renovated, we tried three different styles of shaping. This was done in order for us to test how the bunkers perform in regard to look, playability, drainage and sand wash. We will be monitoring these bunkers over the next few months and will put what we learn to use as we move forward with more bunker renovations next year. It will take a little time for the sand to completely pack down, but any feedback you provide us would be appreciated.
